

### LEGAL ENGLISH CLASSIX PROGRAMME

#### COURSE OVERVIEW

A 2-week course of 50 hours, taught in groups of 6 in the mornings and groups of 12 in the afternoons. This course is aimed at giving participants both a broad knowledge of legal English and intensive practical experience.

The course is designed for people who need to use Legal English in their studies, their working lives or to pass the TOLES exam.

A combination of authentic tasks, workshops and language input sessions will be used to achieve the course outcomes.

#### COURSE COMPONENTS

**Task Knowledge (9.00 - 10.00)** – This session presents the language – lexis, structure and expression – that can be used in a range of legal scenarios. A typical business or work context is set and then explored. Language as well as skills input relevant to the task are analysed and dissected to see how best to reach your objectives from the task.

**Active Scenario (10.15 - 11.15)** – The context developed in the first hour of the afternoon is now run, examining legal case studies. With post-task evaluation and reflection, as well as any language work from the task that needs attention.

**Knowledge for the Legal Community (11.30 - 12.30)** – This session builds fluency and language competence by encouraging presentations and dialogue on themes relating to the legal world.

**Language Focus (13.30 - 14.30)** – Students cover further points of grammar, vocabulary and skills practice. This session will help you develop your techniques in reading, listening and writing.

**Spoken Performance Workshop (14.45 - 15.45)** – This workshop encourages your fluency in a range of speaking situations through role-plays, pair work and public speaking activities to achieve confident performance in the spoken language.

**Optional Individual Tuition (16.00 - 17.00)** – The chance for participants to take an hour of personalised tuition each day to focus on language work or further study in the field of law. You could also prepare for the Test of Legal English Skills (TOLES exam).

#### During the course students will also:

- Visit a court in Oxford to see British law in action first hand
- Attend a talk by a legal professional with Q & A session
- Receive personal coaching to discuss progress, goals and ambitions
