

English World for Medicine 2019

This highly structured 4 week programme provides students with the knowledge, skills and confidence to use English effectively with patients and medical professionals in order to provide medical care. The course builds core knowledge in medical terminology using case studies which explore patient conditions and medical situations. The course includes 25 hours of study per week, plus 1.5 hours of plenaries, workshops and a 1:1 coaching session.



Daily Course Timetable

08.45-09.00	Plenary – gain confidence in public speaking
09.00-10.00	Skills Training – gain comprehension and expression skills
10.15-11.15	Accuracy in Grammar – gain enhanced accuracy of language use in medical situations
11.30-12.30	Knowledge for the Medical Community – gain specific knowledge and vocabulary for medicine
13.30-14.30	Communication skills for the medical practitioner – develop skills and awareness
14.45-15.45	Confident spoken performance for the medical practitioner – gain professional confidence

Course Overview

This course develops participants' language, skills and knowledge in English for medical situations. In the Knowledge for the Medical Community session we build and extend vocabulary in a wide range of medical areas including:

- Anatomy – parts of the body
- Diseases and symptoms – bones, childhood illnesses, heart, mental illness, oncology
- Investigations – tests, endoscopy, scans
- Treatment – pharmacy, surgery, palliative care, pain management, occupational and physiotherapy
- Prevention – screening and immunization



The afternoon sessions are highly practical and develop the communication skills of the medical practitioner in the following areas:

- Introduction to communication skills
- Past medical and family history
- Examining a patient
- Giving results
- Planning treatment and closing the interview
- Dealing with sensitive issues
- Communicating with children, the elderly and challenging patients
