COURSE OUTLINE

Teaching Methodology (9.00 – 12.30)

The group will explore practical and stimulating ways to make learning effective. This session will focus on methods and skills required to teach grammar, vocabulary and phonology as well as receptive and productive skills. Course participants discuss 'the reflective teacher', how to maximise student motivation, how students learn, and the teacher's role: coach, facilitator, mentor. Using role-plays, discussions and presentations we'll also focus on confidence and fluency in spoken English, as well as performance skills that can be replicated in the classroom.

Language Focus (13.30 – 15.45)

These two hours are dedicated to improving your general competence in English: comprehension, fluency and vocabulary expansion. You will be able to develop your language competence and effective communication skills for the global community. There are also opportunities to observe and give feedback on English language classes and discuss best practice with our teachers.

COURSE EXTRAS

Plenary Sessions (8.45 – 9.00)

Our plenaries mean you start each day with an inspirational presentation or activity. You will not only attend these but also lead one, giving you the opportunity to share your experiences and attempt new techniques.

Extra Training (12.30 – 13.00 on Thursday)

You will join our teaching team for one of our regular in-house training sessions which take place at lunchtimes on Thursday. You will discuss and learn about an aspect of teaching pedagogy with the Regent team.

Practice Lesson (16.00 – 17.00 on Wednesday)

You will have one hour each week after school to teach a group of students. You will plan a lesson with your trainer and the other participants, deliver the lesson and receive constructive feedback.
