POLICY ON ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR

We want:

- to actively promote inter-cultural understanding
- to encourage appreciation of the different ways we all live, think and learn
- you to help us ensure that Regent Home Tuition and your home is a place of tolerance and friendship

Abusive behaviour may be unlawful. Our policy is that is always unacceptable

Abusive behaviour includes but is not limited to:

- verbal abuse
- bullying
- actual or threatened violence
- damage to personal or Regent Home Tuition property
- discrimination, victimisation or harassment based on race, colour, gender, religion or age
- criminal activities
- misuse of substances

Such behaviour may result:

- in the case of staff, in disciplinary action
- in the case of students, immediate termination of course

If you believe that you have been subjected to any form of abusive behaviour, you should report the incident to the Regional Director of Studies and / or the Manager of Regent Home Tuition at Head Office immediately. Any accusations of abusive behaviour will be logged and investigated by the Manager of Regent Home Tuition.
